How Much Gumbo: Each entry should include enough for 200 - 2oz. samples or a minimum of 3 gallons of gumbo. Samples should only be given to persons who are wearing an event wristband.

Judging: The "Judge's Choice" award will be decided by a panel of judges. The "People's Choice" award will be determined by the gumbo entry with the highest number of votes. Voting ends at 8:30 pm. Winners will be announced later that evening. The team that wins the "Judge's Choice" award is not eligible for the "People's Choice" award.
